Settled status

You are eligible to apply for settled status if you:

- Started living in the UK by 31 December 2020
- Have lived in the UK continuously for 5 years

You will be able to:

- ✓ Work in the UK
- ✓ Access the NHS
- ✓ Enrol in education or continue studying
- ✓ Travel in and out of the UK
- ✓ Access public funds such as benefits and pensions
- ✓ Stay in the UK as long as you like
- ✓ Bring your family to live in the UK

EU citizens with settled status have the same rights as they did before Brexit.

Pre-settled status

You are eligible to apply for pre-settled status if you:

- Started living in the UK by 31 December 2020
- Have lived in the UK for less than 5 years

With pre-settled status you will be able to:

- ✓ Work in the UK
- ✓ Access the NHS
- ✓ Enrol in education or continue studying
- ✓ Travel in and out of the UK
- * Have limited access to public funds (subject to change).
- * Bring certain family members to live in the UK (subject to change)

You should apply for settled status once you have lived in the UK for up to 5 years continuously.
